## Peak of the day:



### President's dialogue with the youth of the world

The President of the Republic spoke today with the youth of the world, he talked about a number of issues such as education, political Islam, the fight against terrorism and entrepreneurship, the issue of refugees, creating jobs and infrastructure development, the issue of independence of Arab countries and the coming elections in April. He stressed that the first step to counter terrorism is good education, and that the achievement of the past three years is the beginning of a new program launched by the government within two years to develop a 14-year education strategy to overcome the problems of education in Egypt.

On the issue of the refugees and Egypt's readiness to receive more refugees, President Al Sisi stressed that Egypt is absorbing the refugees. We have 5 million refugees. We do not differentiate between Egyptians and foreigners. There are no camps of their own, but they integrate into society without discrimination.

On entrepreneurship and job creation in Egypt, the president stressed that it is necessary to stabilize and develop infrastructure. The president praised that we have made great progress in the development of infrastructure and housing. There is a new generation of cities reaching 13 new cities targeting a large sector has been provided jobs and the project was launched small and micro-industries with the support of 200 billion pounds With a %5 interest rate for youth. There are about 3 million people working in infrastructure projects in Egypt.

## More about the discussions:

### MUN

President of the session saluted the Egyptian President and declared that this session is dedicated to address future generations to send a message of peace to the whole world.

Then the Rapporteur of the session declared the official procedure of the session and called the names of the 20 delegations taking part in this session. They were all present.

Then the President of the session started calling the delegations to speak.



### Inspiring experiences from the youth around the world

Farida Tamraza started saying, Positive thinking is the goal that gathered us here and we will start with it.

Then Marwa El-Selhedar started her speech as an inspiring model saying the challenge lies in education and strength to meet the challenges

Mr. Michel Johnson who is one of the 30 most important and successful scientist around the world noted that each one has to look for his talents and appetites and determine the ways s/he can improve them

After that, the guests started asking their questions about how to discover yourself and your abilities and how can others discover your talents.

### The Egyptian experience in hosting refugees

The session started with the screening of a documentary about refugees. "Rafaa El-Rifaa" said that she left Damascus in 2012, where it was really dangerous to make it out of her home. Then she came into Egypt, and she did volunteer work. And she also stressed that when a woman suffers, the whole community suffers as well.

Ghada Waly mentioned that there are more than 22.5 million refugees in all over the world; Syria, Sudan and Afghanistan represent about %55 of that number. And they represent one third of the population in the hosting countries.

She also mentioned some points regarding hosting refugees in Egypt:

- There is a lot of weight and respect for Syria and Iraq.
- A lot of Egyptians got married to a lot of Syrians.
- A lot of Syrians have started their businesses in Egypt, and there is a long history of good relations between the two countries.



### Challenges and issues facing world youth: Means to overcome towards building a better future

The session began with a speech by the Chadian President in which he said that the first challenge we face is the security challenge in terms of terrorism and the associated crises of the election process both before and after. It is also challenging that young people have been forced to migrate illegally to seek solutions elsewhere despite the problems they face during that journey.

After that, the Yazidi Activist Lamia Hajji, a fugitive from the hell of ISIS, told the audience the story of ISIS breaking into her village, killing men, selling women in markets they prepare and hanging pictures of women in their own legal court as an advertisement.

After that, President Abdel-Fattah Al-Sisi's speech addressed an advice to the youth of the world, stressing that dealing with matters that are not based on real knowledge and real science is more harmful than useful.

The most important recommendation that came out of the session was the launch of an electronic platform for dialogue through the World Youth Forum to develop a unified strategy to meet those challenges are held periodically until the next forum.

### Press freedom .. why it matters

This discussion session came out with several recommendations, the most important of which are:

- 1 - The press have to create positive, and give attention to information in addition to spreading the thought of participation and social responsibility.
- 2 - Freedom of circulation of information and are victims of rumors in the means of social communication and others.
- 3 - to understand the culture of dialogue in the curricula accepted by children
- 4 - Compel all media workers with codes of conduct in newspapers and be mandatory and associated with the issuance of any newspaper in addition to maintaining and supporting the Charter of Information Honor

There are a number of events and activities that are held besides the regular forum sessions, which include art and cultural shows, sports events, musical concerts, and other activities and events that enable more communication and integration between youth of different cultures.
